

Year 4

This term, our classroom has been buzzing with creativity, curiosity and collaboration. We began by stepping into the world of poetry, discovering the power of words through haikus, tankas and limericks. From playful rhymes to reflective moments, the students have been experimenting with language and learning how poetic devices shape meaning.

Meanwhile, our inquiry in HASS led us on a journey through time as we explored the lives and cultures of the First Australians. Students were fascinated by the diversity among communities and the deep connection to Country and Place that continues today.

In Maths, a burst of design energy took over as symmetry and fractions found a real-world purpose increating our own surfboards, snowboards and skateboards. Measuring, folding, sketching and calculating, students brought maths to life through their personalised creations.

Our curiosity extended to the science lab, where we used Makey Makeys to test which materials are conductors and which are insulators. That led naturally into our technology unit, where we explored the digital world of inputs and outputs, finding connections between the tools we use every day and the systems behind them.

Collaboration has been a strong focus, with jigsaw activities giving students the chance to become experts on a topic before returning to teach it to their group. This approach transforms learners into teachers and helps build confidence and understanding.

And finally, in HASS, we used physical movement to practise historical thinking. Students stepped left or right to show whether they thought a source was primary or secondary, then explained the reasoning behind their choices.

It has been a rich and varied term, full of hands-on learning, thoughtful discussion and shared discoveries.

We were warmly welcomed into their assembly and joined the morning exercise routine. We met all of the teachers, who shared how long they had been at the school. Many were former students who returned to teach after graduating, with the youngest only 18 years old. While none hold formal teaching qualifications, their passion for education is unmistakable.



The day highlighted two CAS projects: Tahlia's penpal initiative and Mackenzie and Charlotte's project on teaching study skills to help students improve their learning. Our school also donated stationery for use in the penpal program, and the three girls enjoyed reuniting with their penpals. Charlotte and Mackenzie led four consecutive study skills sessions, from Grade 4 through to the senior students. The sessions were lively and interactive, with students eager to learn and contribute ideas.
