

1. What is the application process?

Applicants who have submitted all required documents and essay will be selected to take online Mathematics and English Tests, to be taken on Friday and Sat, 13-14 December 2019. The tests take approximately 2 hours and will be taken at AIS Jakarta.

Applicants selected to go through the next application process will be invited for an interview with the scholarship panel, between January 2020. Invitation notification will be sent by email. Interviews will be held in English for approximately an hour at the AIS Pejaten Campus.

2. When will classes actually start?

AIS runs on a January-December academic calendar. However scholarship recipients can join classes starting from mid-April 2020.

3. What documents do I need to submit?

Documents for application include:

1. School Report for the past two years,
2. Completed Application Form
3. Copy of passport and birth certificate
4. Two passport size photos of students
5. 500-word essay in English
6. Copy of SKHUN
7. Copy of Junior High School Certificate

4. What other costs will I have to pay?

The scholarship program does not cover uniform costs, cost of camps and extra-curricular activities.

5. My child is in Grade 9, can he apply?

No, all applicants will need to be in Grade 10 at the time of application.

6. My child is 16 years of age in Grade 10, can he apply?

Yes, he can apply.

7. My child is 14 years of age in Grade 10, can he apply?

Applicants need to be 15 years of age by March, 2020.

8. My child studies at an Indonesian school in Grade 10, can he apply?

Yes we accept all applicants from Grade 10 regardless of your current school as long as all documents are submitted.

9. My child has Indonesian citizenship but will not relocate to Indonesia until after April 2020. Can he apply?

Yes, he can apply but will need to be able to attend an interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee between January 2020.

10. Can the online test be taken from other cities outside of Jakarta?

If applicants cannot take the test at AIS Pejaten Campus, the tests can be taken off-site, verified by the applicant's school invigilator. Details on this option will be stated in the email invitation, should applicants be selected to take the Online Tests.

11. Will the essay need to be typed or handwritten?

It can be typed or handwritten.

12. If I receive the scholarship is it possible to study at AIS Kemang or Bali?

No, the scholarship program is only available at AIS Pejaten.

13. Can I receive the cash amount instead of the scholarship, as I don't live close to AIS Pejaten?

No, the scholarship is not exchangeable or transferable.

14. If I receive the scholarship, can I start studies from 2019?

The scholarship program is valid for start in April 2020, or earlier.

15. May I submit the essay in Indonesian?

No, essays must be submitted in English.

16. Is the IB Diploma acceptable in local universities?

Yes it is recognized in local universities. Local national university entrance exams will also determine acceptance at public universities.

17. Is the IB Diploma certificate acceptable in overseas universities outside of Australia?

Yes, it is and is perhaps the most widely recognized qualification.

18. If awarded the scholarship, is there any penalty if my child exits before Grade 12?

No.

19. Is there any minimum grade required to maintain the scholarship?

A high level of academic performance will be expected in order to continue within the scholarship.

20. Does AIS provide boarding?

No, AIS does not provide boarding facilities.

21. Will transport be provided?

No, transport is not part of this scholarship however transport can be provided according to our cost schedule.

22. Can this scholarship be used for studying at any AIS school or schools in Australia?

This scholarship is awarded for studying at AIS Pejaten only.
